# Keep your Damn Hands and Penis to Yourself!!!!

Let me state firstly that I am a guy and secondly if you, kind and lovely reader, are also a male, "Keep your Damn Hands and Penis to Yourself!" As of recently, I was exposed to the reality in which I've been living... I've been unaware of its existence... GROPING IN GUYANA!! Yes, groping!
